

As per the plan, a total of 9000 CUM soil was to be excavated and the same to be transferred to the farmer's land. After the initial councelling of the villagers, the actual project was launched on 5th May, 2019 and completed on 18th June, 2019, within stipulated time limit of hardly 43 days. A total of 16000 CUM of silt was removed as compared to the earlier work plan.


In all, 16000 CUM silt was excavated which equals to 8000 trolleys, and this quantum of silt was transferred to 27 fields of the same village. It was a win-win situation as more rain water would be harvested in coming monsoon and 27 fields will become more productive.

This project made the community to work together day and night for the noble cause of rain water harvesting with the help of technical and social support from our institutions. This project was completed without any financial support from the government. Dr. Pawar and his team in Bodwad played an important role in completion of the project.

- 3. Community worked together as a cohesive team for the noble cause

- An innovative project of joint venture between community and academia



Solar Urja Lamp Competition

The Indian Institute of Technology Bombay has designed the Solar Urja through Localization for Sustainability (SoULS) initiative, which is primarily based on involving local communities in all the operations relating to the deployment of the solar technology. Since students will be the future bearers of the energy and will bear the maximum brunt of climate change, hence, the students have to be an integral part of taking the idea of Energy Swaraj forward and in the transition from fossil fuel-based energy to renewable-based energy. IIT Bombay in collaboration with the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) had organized a solar challenge, referred to as the SOUL Challenge. The challenge was categorized into two problem statements with technical challenge to enhance the efficiency by 2% and have better design using eco-friendly material. 
