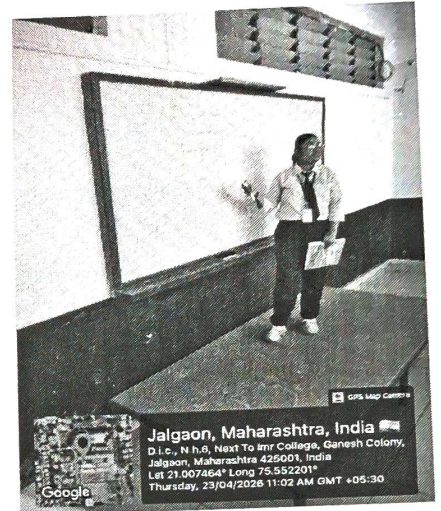
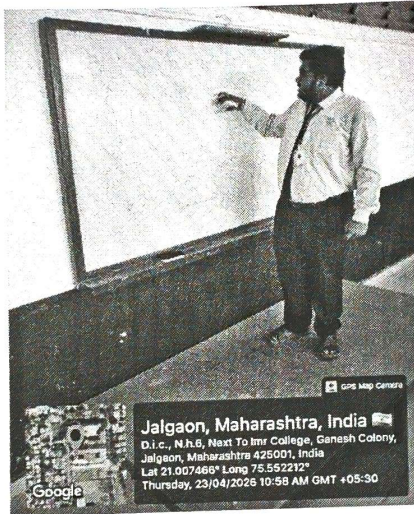
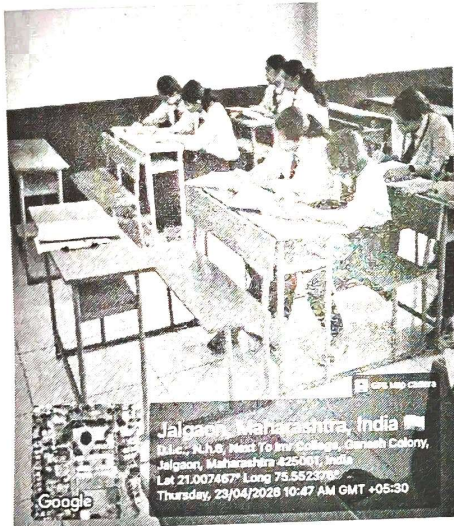
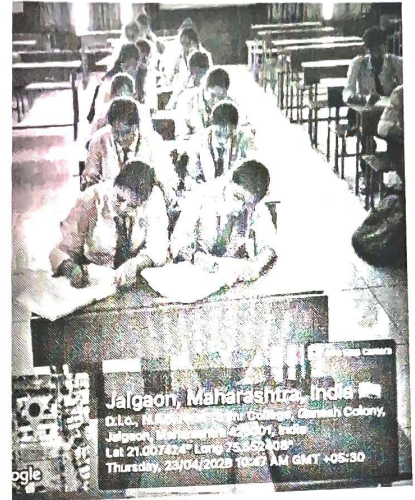
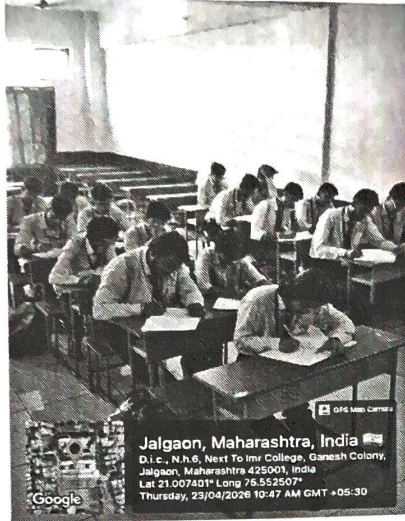
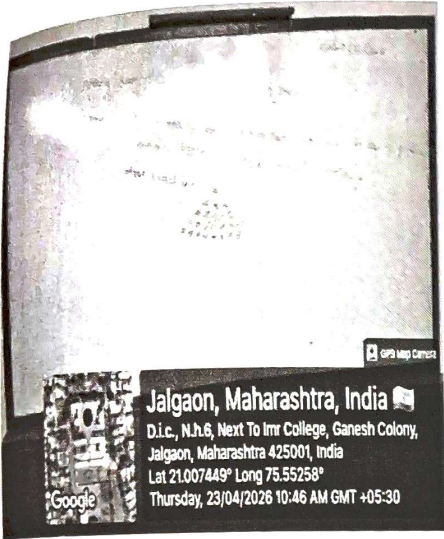
**Short information of the Activity: -**
